

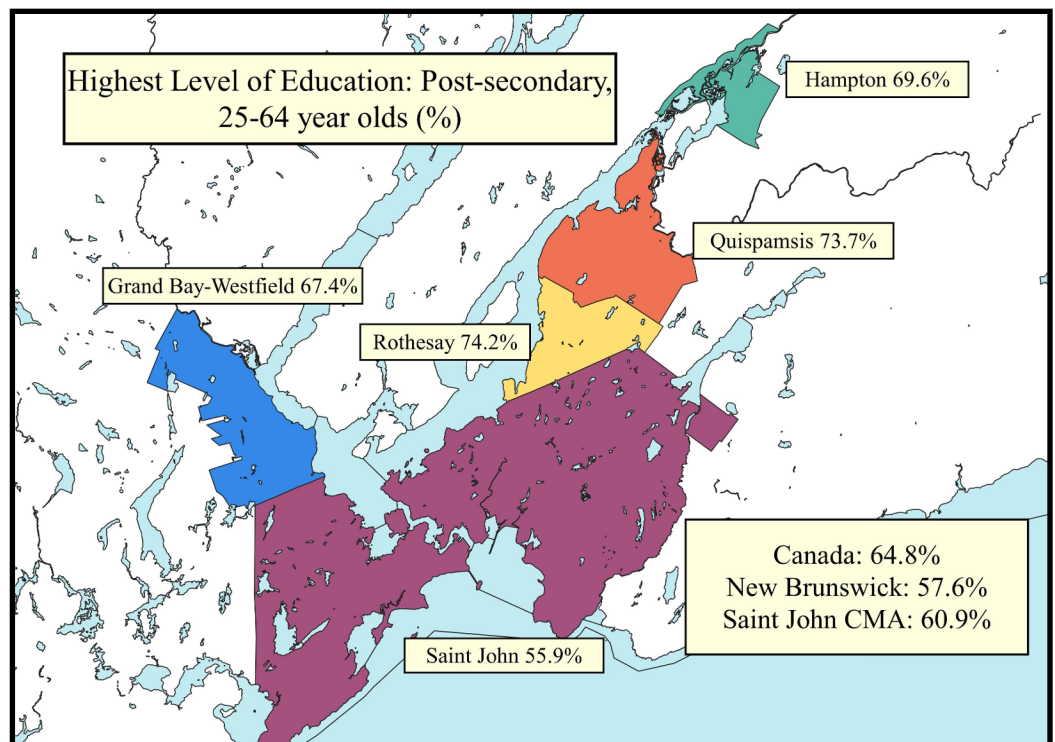

"Highest" Level of Education?

- The census defines the "highest" level of education as the highest diploma, degree or certification that an individual has received.
- Highest level of education ranges from having less than a high school diploma (or GED) to having received post-secondary certification (including College, University, and other certificate programs done after high school).

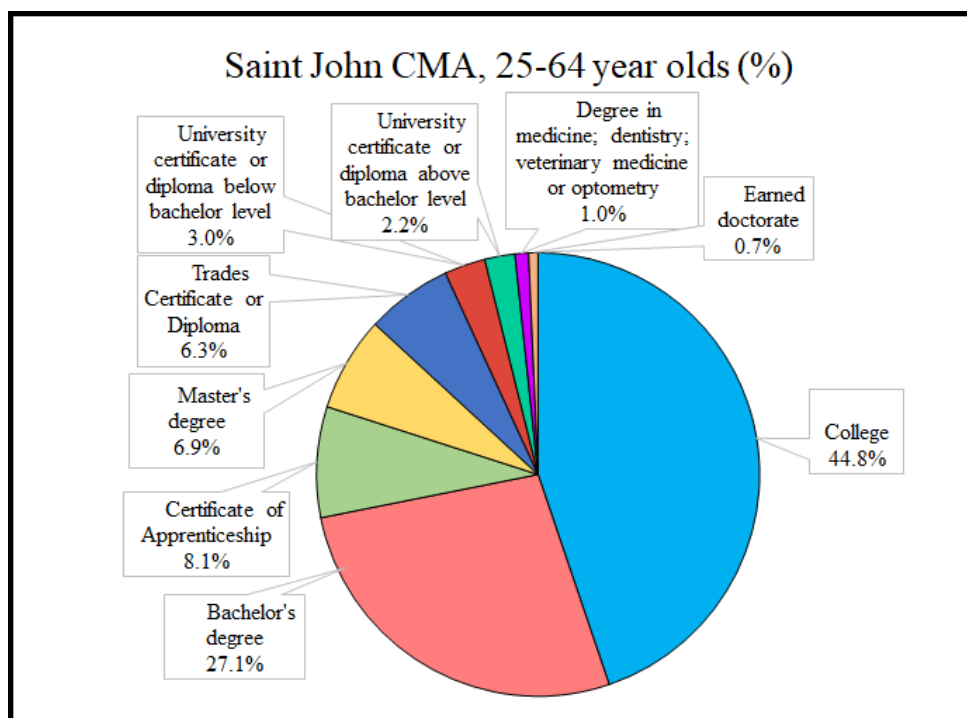

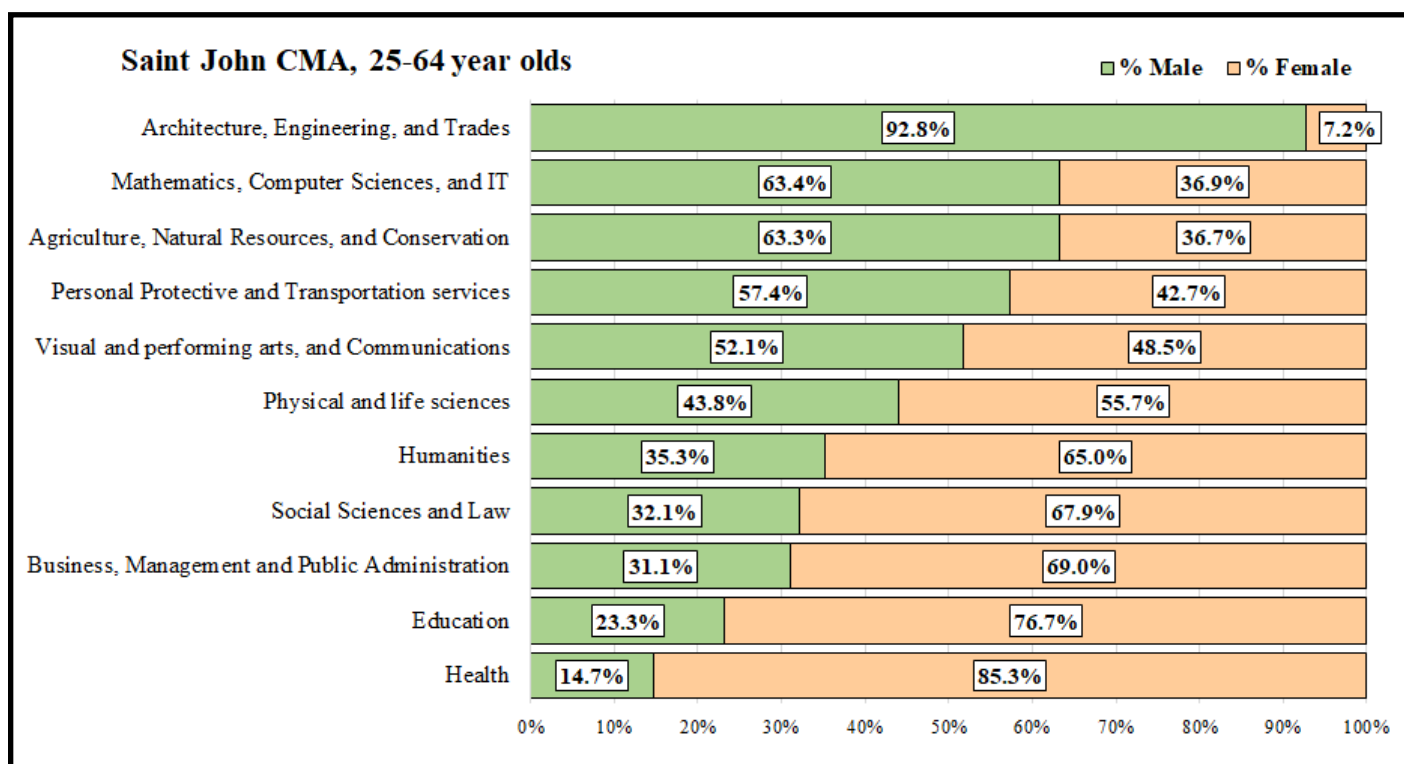
Type of Post-secondary Certification:
