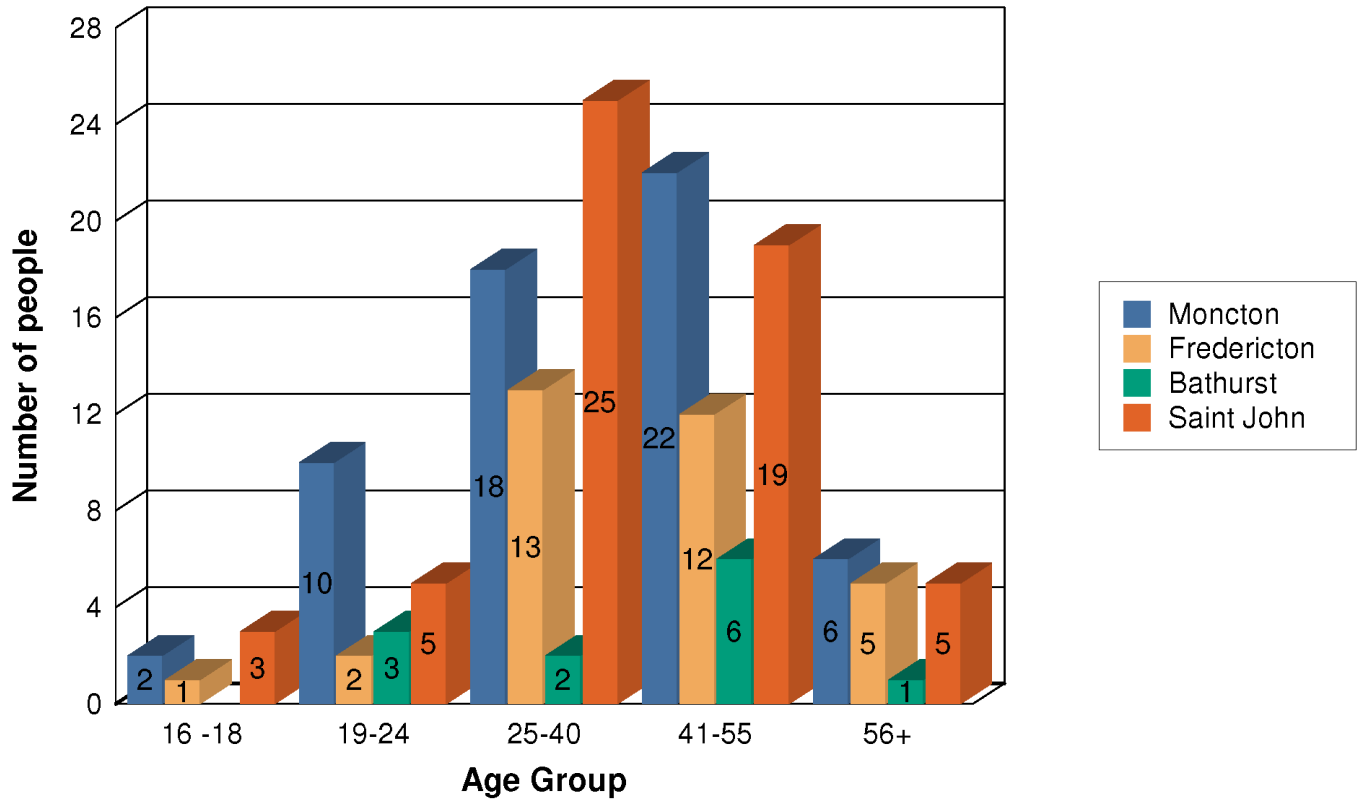

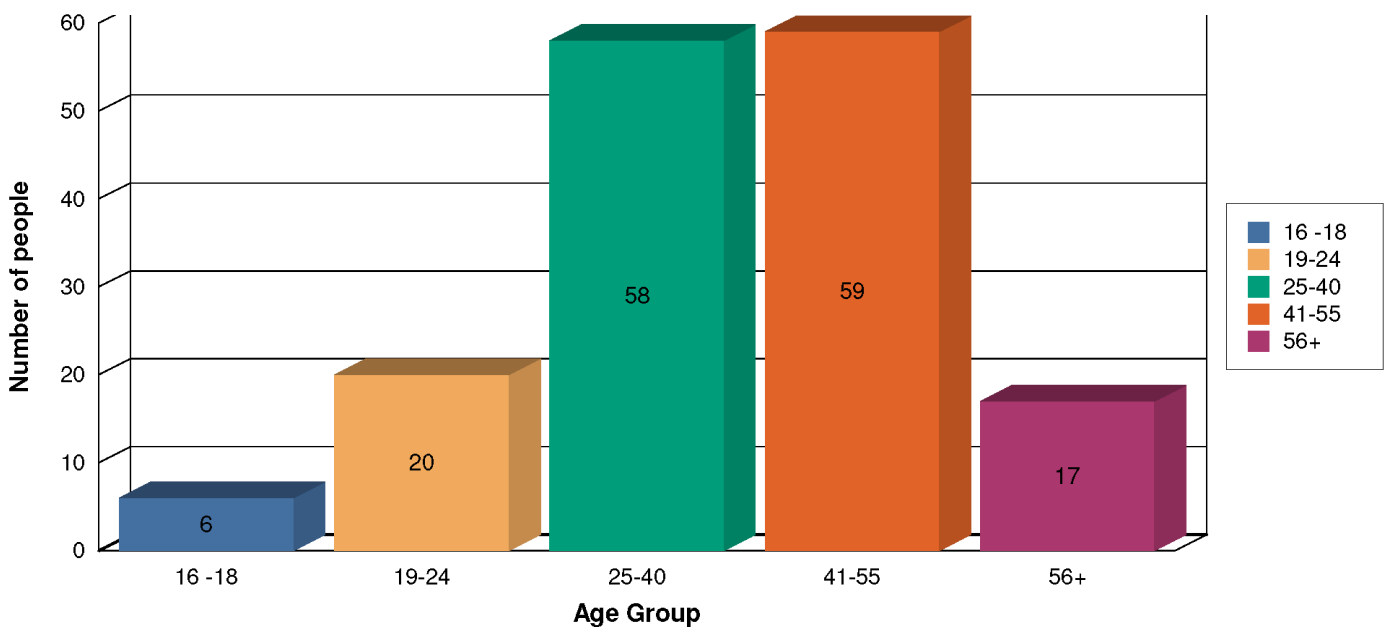

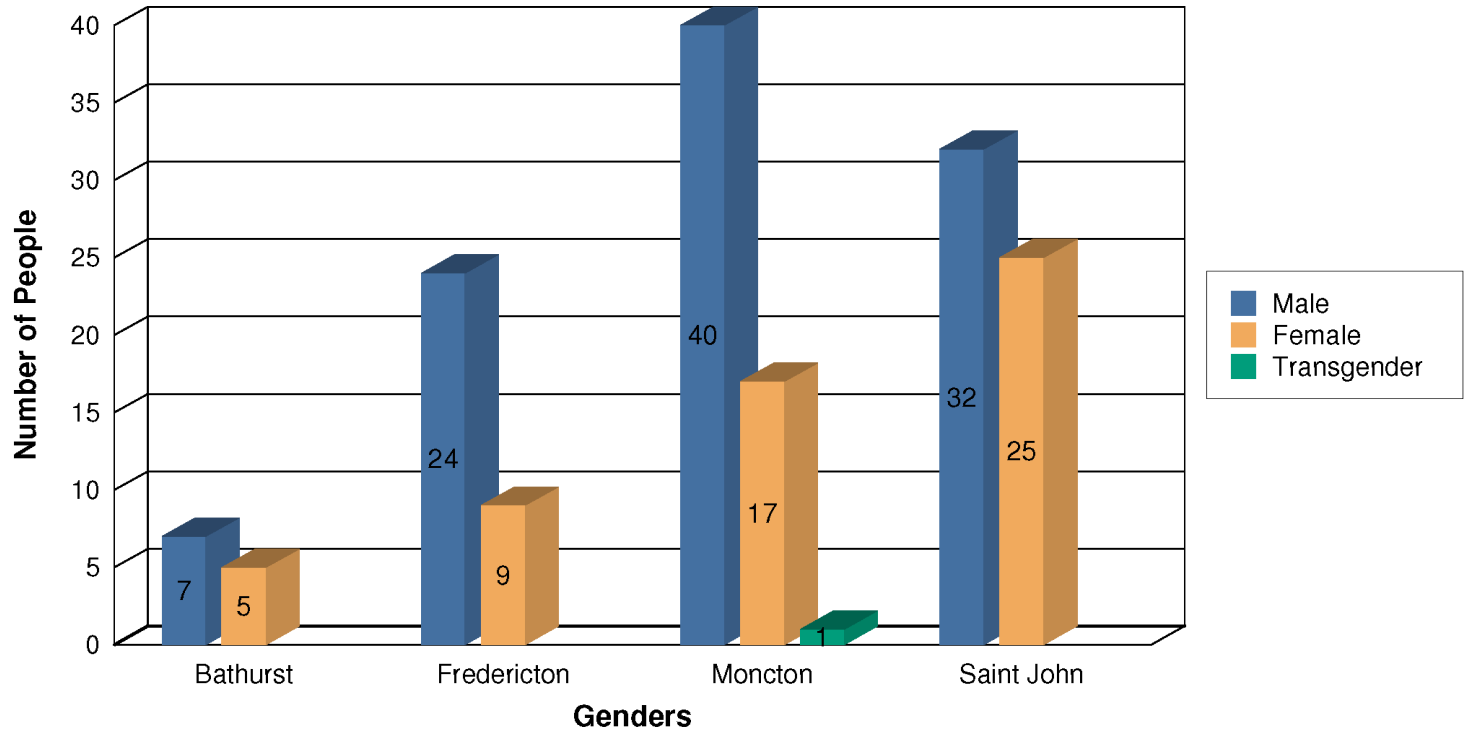
Age Breakdown by City



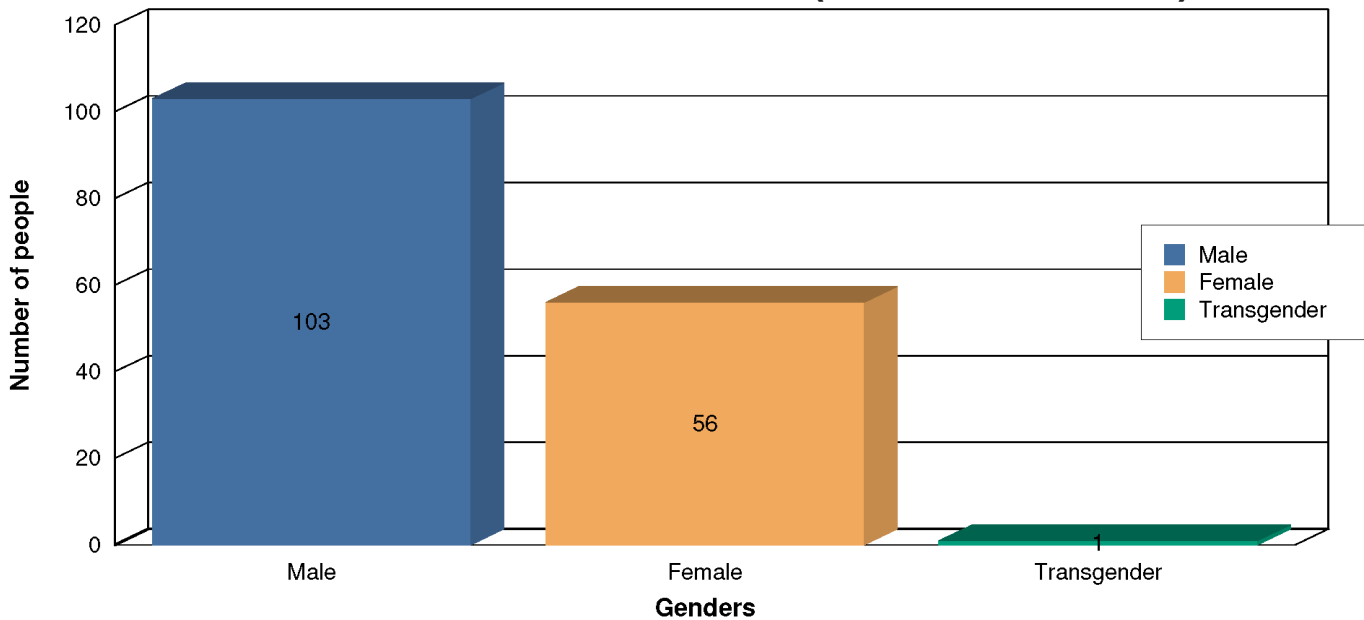
Age Distribution (Combined Data)

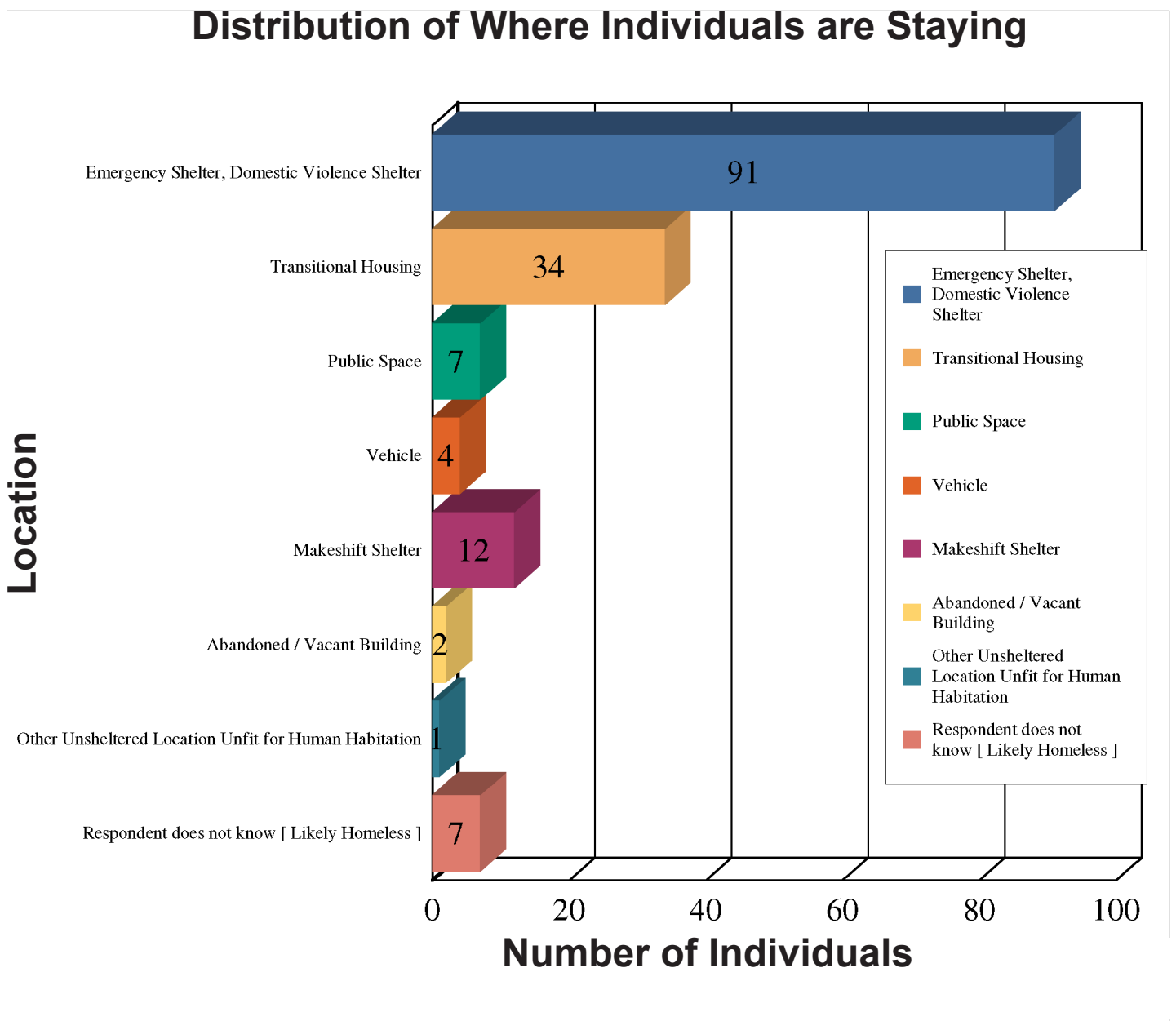

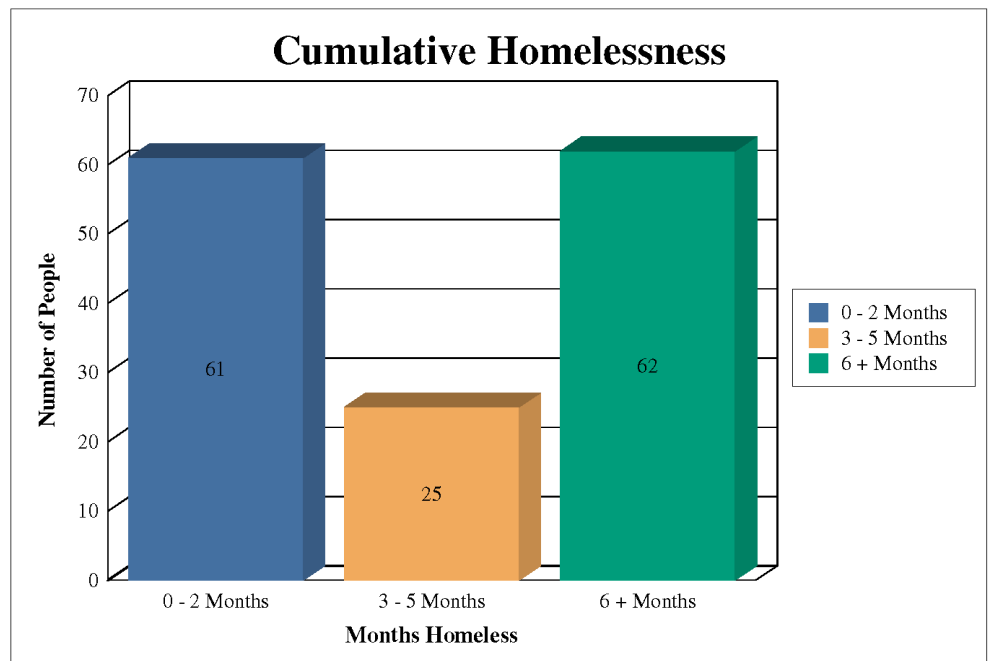
Cumulative and Episodically Homelessness - Combined data

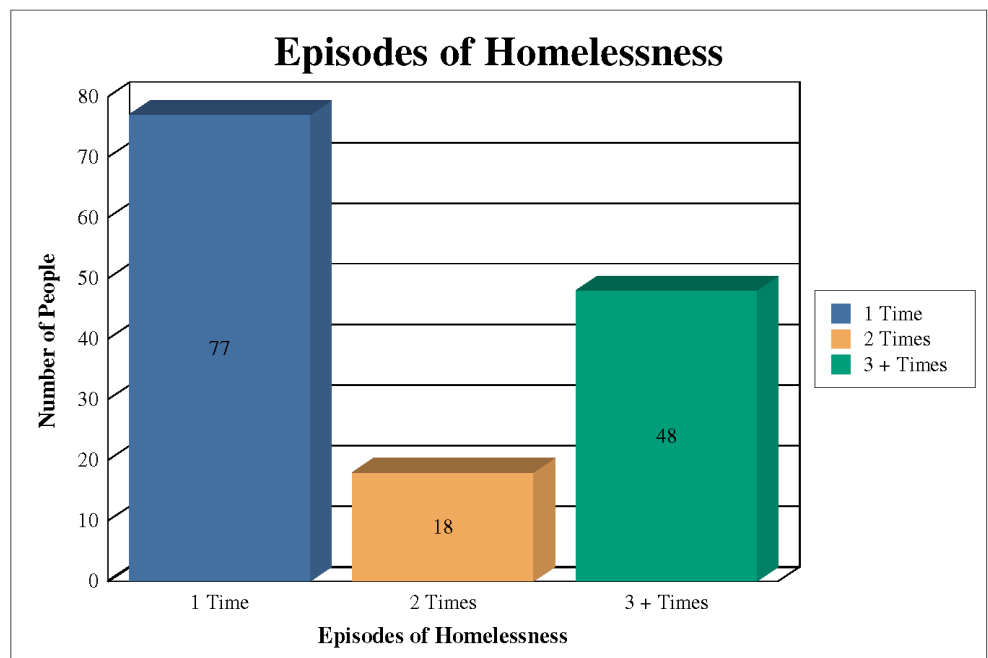

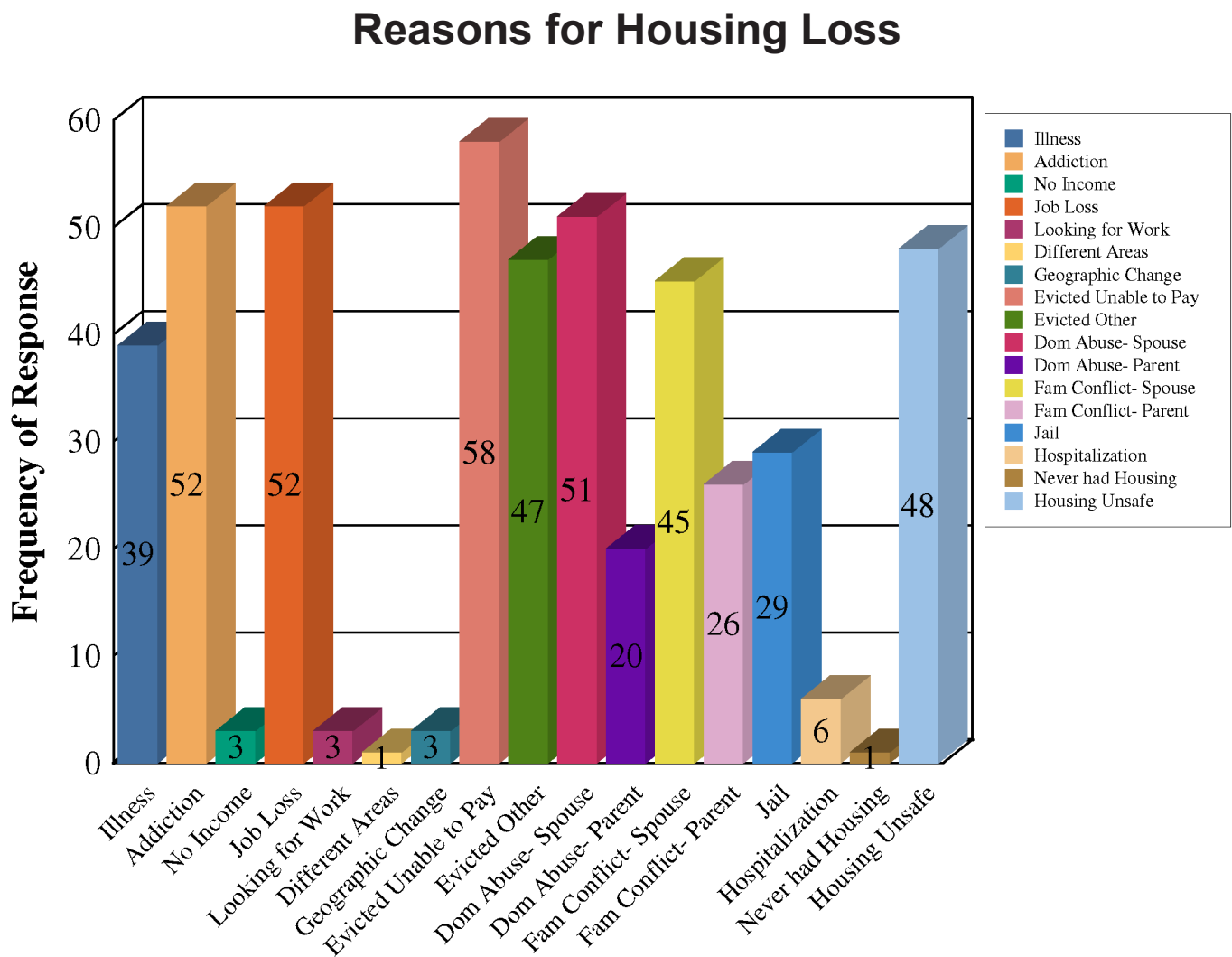

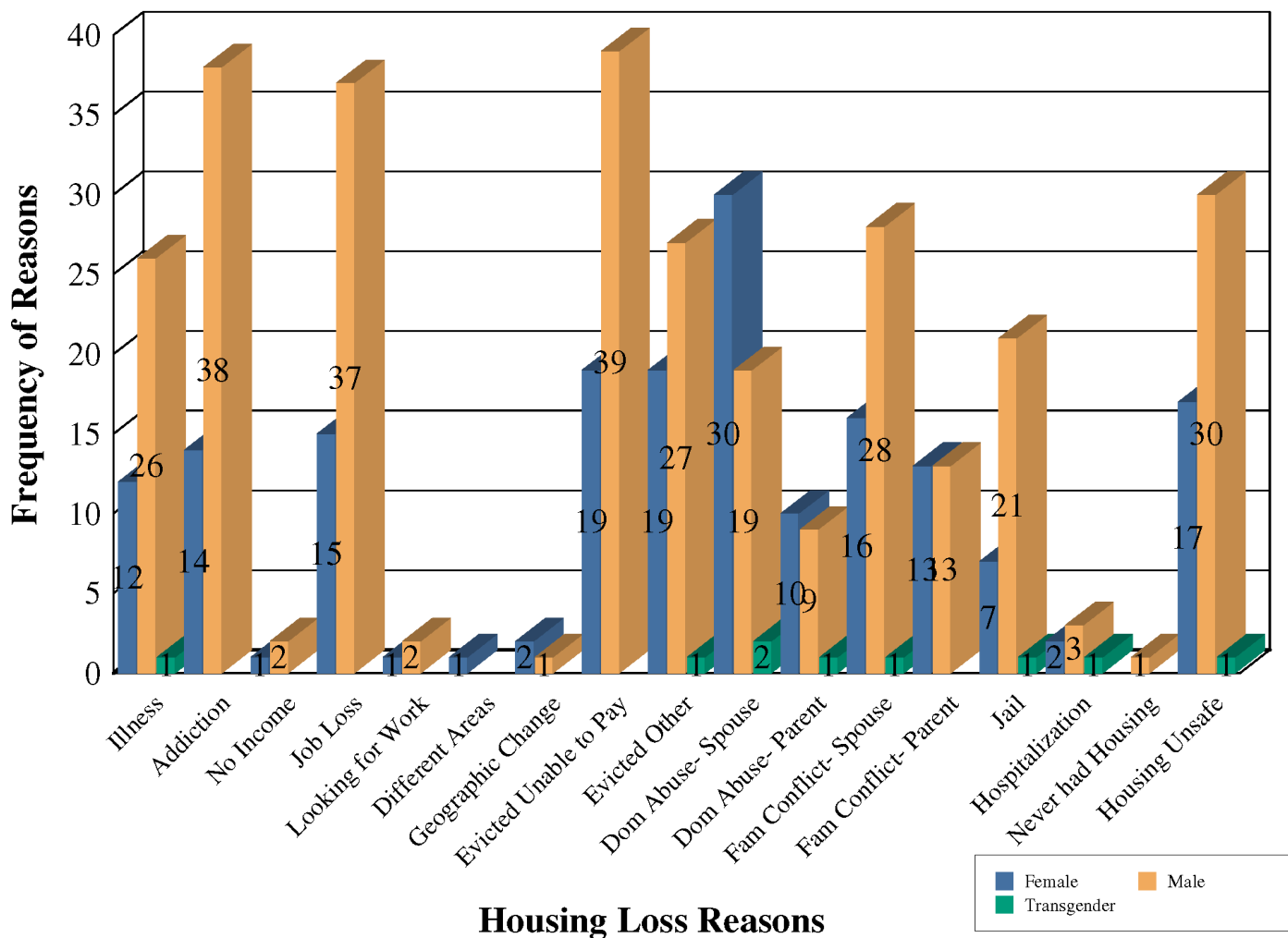

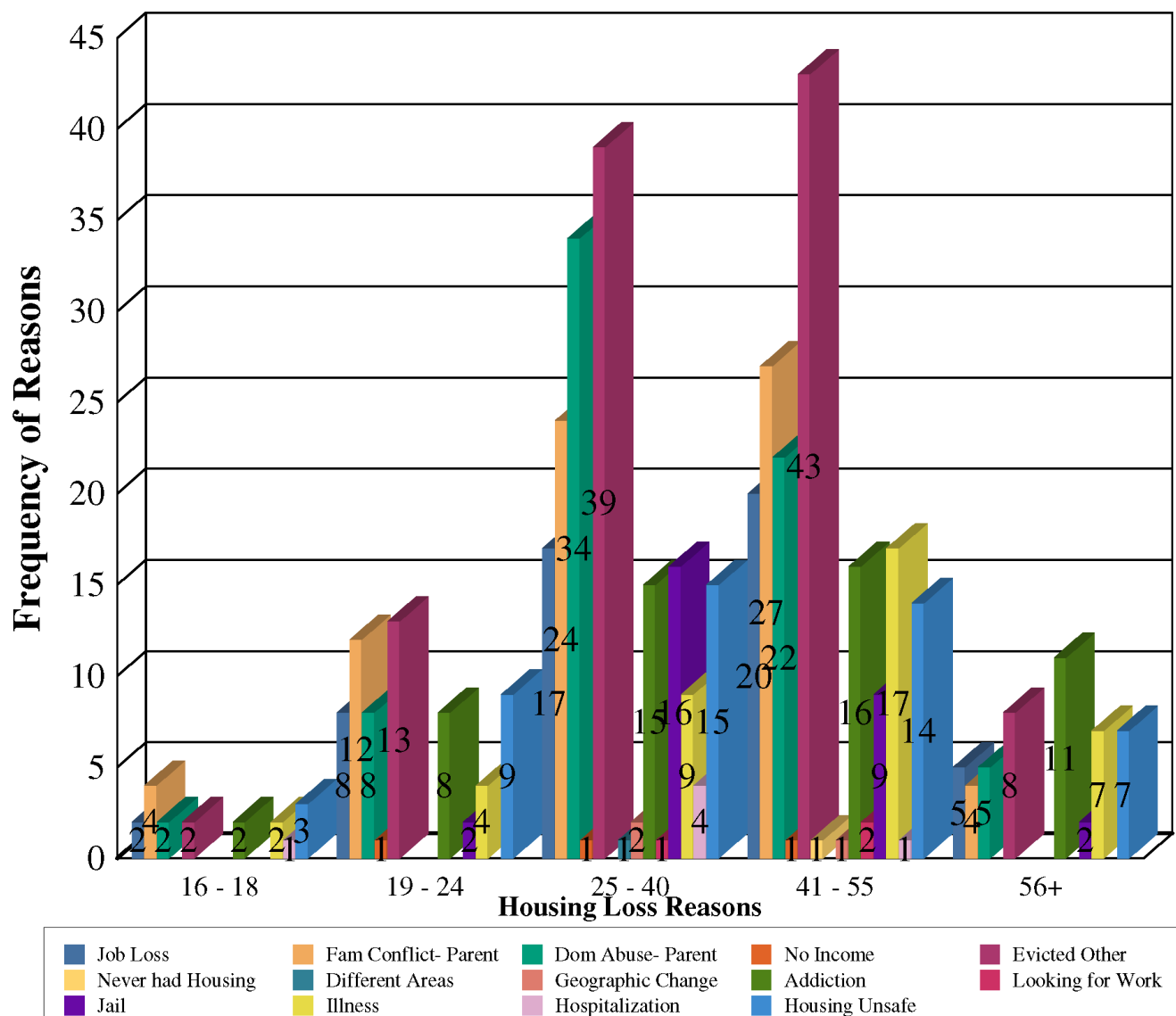
Reasons for Housing Loss by Gender

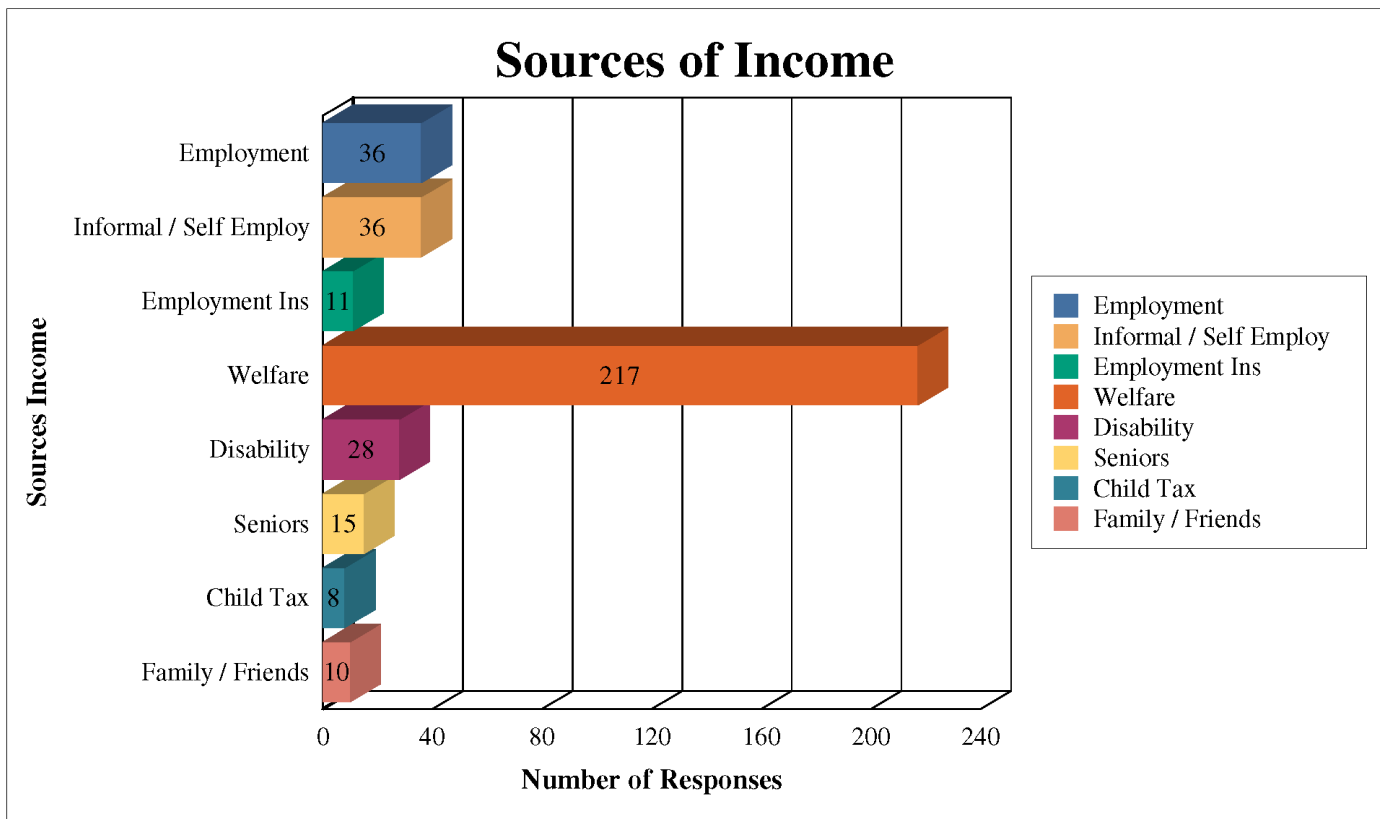
