

Call for Project Summaries:

Homelessness Reduction & Prevention – Rural and Remote New Brunswick

Public Notice:

October 7, 2025

The Human Development Council (HDC), in its role as Community Entity for *Reaching Home, Canada's Homelessness Strategy*, in conjunction with New Brunswick's Rural Advisory Board (RAB) are inviting eligible groups in rural and remote New Brunswick to submit a brief summary of short-term projects (projects ending March 31, 2026) that are ready to go (or underway) that address homelessness or housing instability.

Deadline

The deadline for submission is 5:00pm (AST) Tuesday, October 28, 2025. Late submissions will not be accepted.

Who can apply:

This Call for Project Summaries is seeking to support and leverage the work of Non-profit organizations, Indigenous organizations, and other eligible service providers with a demonstrated commitment to addressing homelessness in small towns, villages and communities in New Brunswick.

Location:

This call for Project Summaries is inviting applicants whose project or services will provide eligible activities in any town, village or city that are outside of the city boundaries of Fredericton, Moncton, Saint John and Bathurst.

Project Summaries

Proponents are asked to submit a concise project summary that is no longer than 2 pages in length. Supporting materials such as quotes, designs or other relevant documents may be included in an appendix.

Summaries must include the following information:

- 1. Organization name, location, contact info
- 2. Project type and status
- 3. Number and types of people to be served
- 4. Services offered / supports included
- 5. Capital & operational cost estimates (if applicable)
- 6. Funding secured / gaps
- 7. Project timelines
- 8. Partnerships (government, nonprofits, other)
- 9. Data & evaluation plan

Projects that meet the Reaching Home eligibility criteria will be invited to submit a full proposal.

Next Steps

All project summaries will be reviewed and scored by the RAB. Proponents whose projects best meet the programs criteria and timeline will be invited to submit additional details as requested.
